Do you have family in Europe?

Tell us!

Tell the interviewer or another official if you have a family member in Europe. You may be reunited with them by the authorities.

When asked, share as much information as you have, think of phone numbers or addresses. Do you have questions? Ask an official for help and to explain the possibility of family reunification to you.

The Dublin III regulation can be used to reunite applicants for international protection with their family members in European countries.
