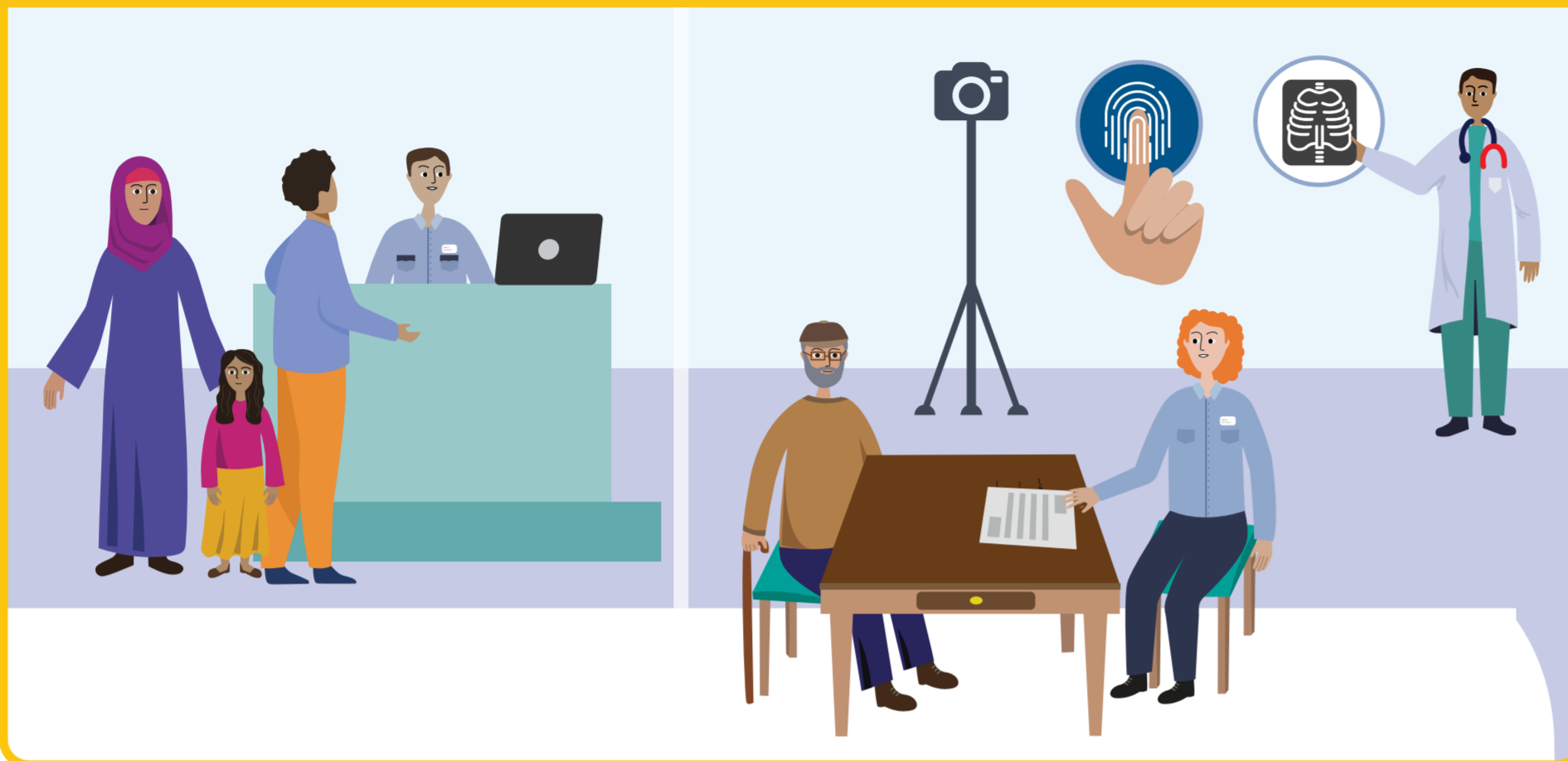


# Steps in the asylum procedure

## 1 Applying for asylum and registration of an application



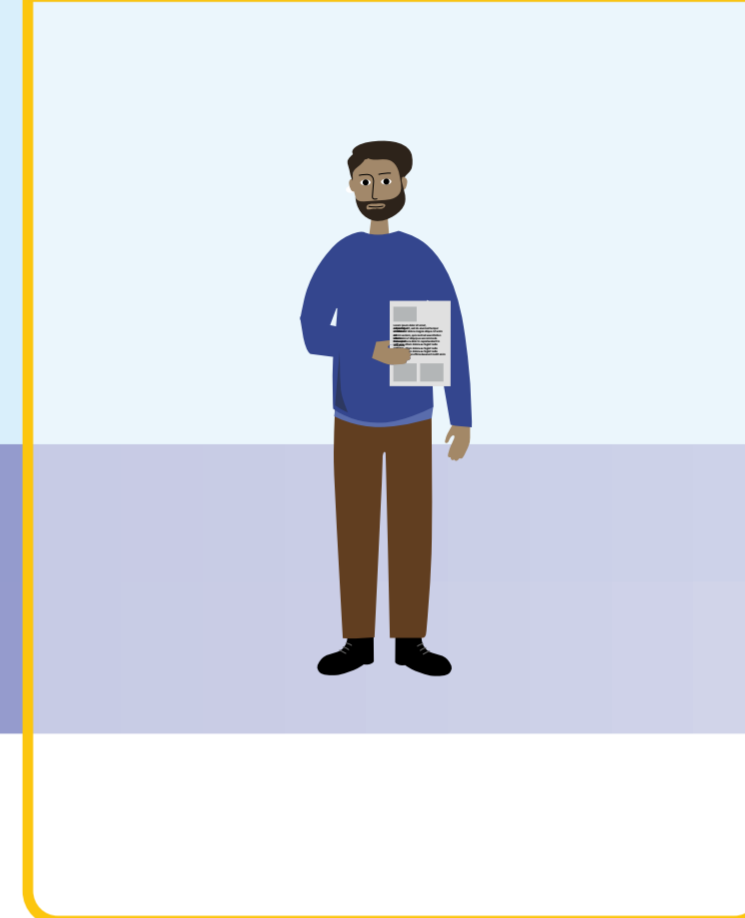

### 1 Applying for asylum and registration of an application

After informing the authorities that you are seeking protection, your application will be registered. During registration:

- your fingerprints will be taken;
- you will be photographed;
- you will need to provide your personal details and your identity documents;
- you may undergo a medical examination and a security search.

### 2 Dublin procedure

The country responsible for your application is decided. If need be, you will be called for an additional interview. Afterwards, you may be transferred to another country that is responsible for your application.

### 3 Personal interview

During the personal interview, you will be asked to present in detail the reason(s) why you are asking for international protection.

### 4 Decision

You receive a written decision on whether or not you have been granted international protection.
